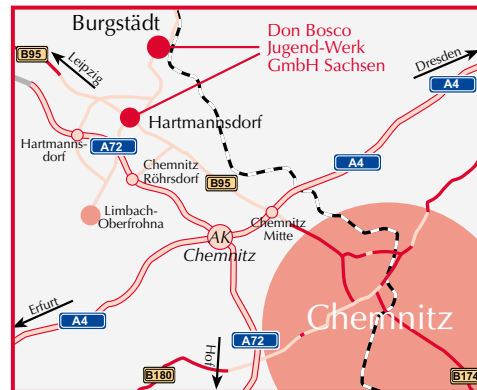

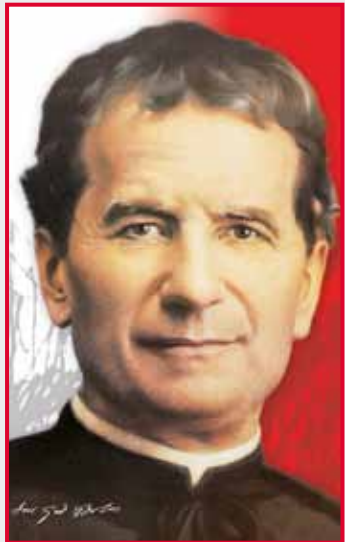

The Don Bosco Jugend-Werk GmbH Sachsen is an inter regional institution for the social and vocational rehabilitation of young people with disabilities. Following a consultation with the employment agency young people are placed with us. During their stay with us, they receive individual support and guidance inspired by the educative insights of Don Bosco.



John Bosco was born on the 16th of August 1815 near Turin. His famous saying "Be joyful, doing good and let the sparrows sing" reflects his positive and joyful spirit, and that of his educational work. Don Bosco trained co-workers and founded a religious community he called the "Salesians of Don Bosco". Today more than

16000 Salesians operate worldwide and promote his concerns about the youth.

On the 31st of January 1888 Don Bosco died. He was canonized in 1934 by Pope Pius XI and worldwide he is renown as Patron Saint of children and young people.

Vocational Preparation (BvB)

In our vocational preparation programme (BvB) we prepare young people who are not yet ready to be fully integrated into the work place or to take up an apprenticeship. The preparation lasts usually 11 months and each adolescent is supported individually.



During the course of the year we give our young people both - a general vocational training and a training directed towards specific professions.
